## **Audrey Grant in Saskatoon**

The Canadian Bridge Federation is funding a tour by Audrey Grant to present lessons and lectures to various Bridge Clubs in Canada, Saskatoon is included in her tour, and she will be in Saskatoon September 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>.

Thursday Sept 22 she will do a session for teachers at 9:00 - 12 AM. then in the afternoon 1:15 - 4:15 a lesson for newer players.

Friday Sept 23 at 9:00 a multi level lesson for intermediate and advanced players. These lessons will be limited to 25 tables at each.

The Thursday morning session is free for all instructors. They are encouraged to attend the lessons to observe teaching techniques.

The lessons will be 3 hours (a small break). Participants will receive text book and course material. Registration should be cut off at 24 tables.

The cost of lessons is \$40, which includes cost of books and material, if you pre register with Jerry Mamer. Walk in registrations on the 22 and 23 will be accepted, these walk-ins however will be \$50. Registrations will begin, August 15. Those wishing to take the teacher's course should also pre register although there is no cost.

Audrey Grant is in the ACBL hall of fame as a teacher. She is Canadian and the pre-eminent teacher and author of books used in bridge lessons all across North America. This is truly a unique opportunity for our Club.
