## **NORTH AMERICAN PAIRS**

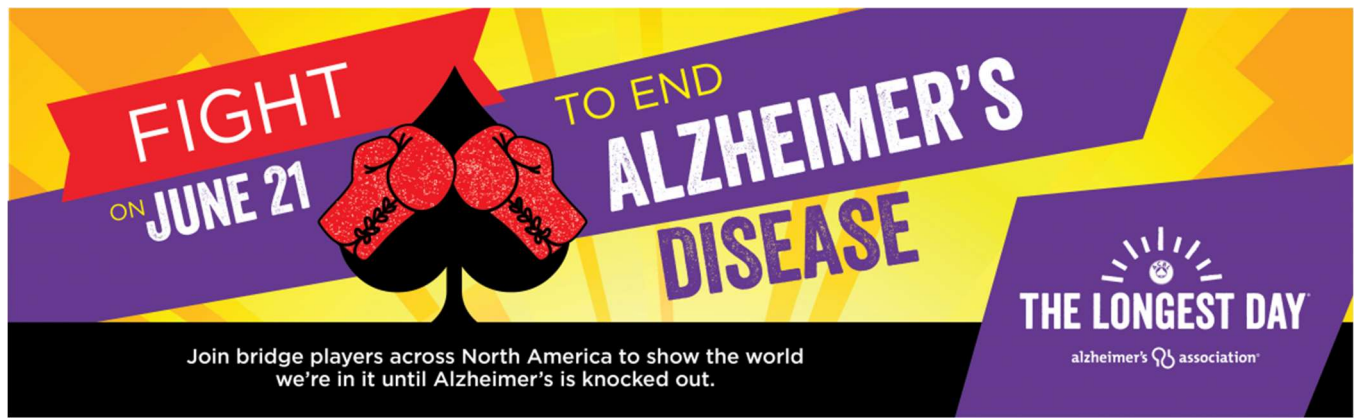
